Seri Bakti successfully completed the first LNG Ship-to-Ship transfer in the Philippines



Seri Bakti has successfully completed the first of multiple Ship-to-Ship (STS) LNG transfers with charterers KOCH Supply & Trading and sub-charterers JOVO (a private Chinese company) and it was the first LNG STS for the three companies involved.

With LNG STS transfers serving in a commercial capacity instead of previously operational, this project represents a key commercial milestone as a recurring transfer, demonstrating the potential of new markets for exporters and provide new supply sources to those with LNG requirements.



Seri Bakti took LNG cargo of 147,000 cbm at GLNG, Australia before transferring them into two parcels on board a smaller vessel, Polar Spirit at Subic Bay in the Philippines. The operations were carefully managed by LNG STS (Teekay Marine Solutions) with shipowners MISC and Teekay providing their extensive LNG experience to administer a safe and successful transfer. The cargo was then delivered to JOVO's China terminal Donguan.
