

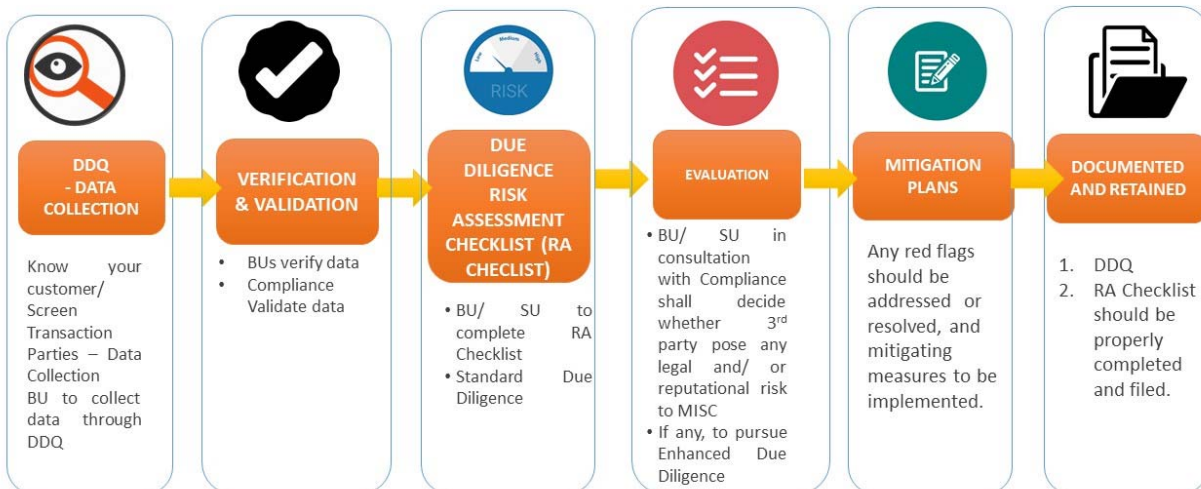


Due Diligence

MISC undertakes due diligence prior to entering into any business relationship with our business partners to evaluate and ensure that our counterparties will meet MISC’s Code of Conduct and Business Ethics (CoBE) requirements and obligations.

Compliance Due Diligence is conducted with the MISC Due Diligence Guidelines on third parties and/ or counterparties who are entering into or have existing contractual relationship with MISC. MISC has developed the Due Diligence Operational Guidelines that cover anti-corruption provisions and requirements to complete anti-corruption Due Diligence Questionnaires (DDQs) or Enhanced DDQs (for High Risk counter-parties) imposed on all counterparties. Where 'red flags' are identified, the appropriate mitigation plans are then initiated and executed.
